- Include the correct name and dosage of your medications on the green history form.
- · Bring any and all insurance cards that apply.
- If your insurance company provides forms which we must complete in order for payment to be made, please remember to bring them with you. Without those forms, you will need to pay us for your visit and receive reimbursement from your insurance company when the forms are completed.
- Also, if your insurance requires a referral from a primary physician, please have it prior to your appointment with us.
- All insurance co-pays and deductibles are payable at the time services are rendered, so please be prepared to pay those charges at the conclusion of your visit.

We are located on Greater Mack Avenue at Shady Lane, about a quarter-mile north of Eight Mile Road. (St. Joan of Arc Church is across the street from us!) We are east of I-94 and either the Vernier Exit or the Nine Mile Road Exit will bring you here quickly.
